## THE 6 TYPES OF SESSIONS

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### GENERAL SESSION

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These 90-120 minute sessions are based on topics that are familiar to the general membership.

They consist of submitted abstracts that reflect the most current research in the field.

### SYMPOSIA

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Symposia feature single lead speakers and related abstracts over 90-120 minutes. They are designed to focus attention on well-defined topics within large disciplines not addressed in regular sessions.

### WORKSHOPS

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Workshops are held just before the start of the formal program and require separate registration. They provide an in-depth educational experience with dedicated question and answer time.

### PANEL DISCUSSIONS

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Panels are intended to foster open debate on specific topics. The invited speakers include renowned experts on the area of focus and dedicated time is allowed for open discussion with the audience.

### TUTORIALS

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The purpose of a tutorial is to teach attendees about a particular technology or focus area. They are free of charge, but attendees should indicate their intention to attend upon registration.

### OTHER EVENTS
